Older and younger siblings are welcome. This is a **no drop-off event** — parents must stay and join the fun!

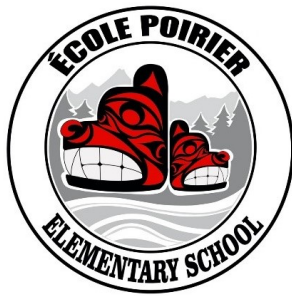
